

Instructions on How to Name Files for Posting to Mayslake Nature Study & Photography Club Flickr Site

Posting of Awards and Honorable Mention Competition Images

Beginning in March 2016 competition images that win Awards and Honorable Mention will be linked to the new Mayslake Nature Study & Photography (MNSPC) website and served up from the Mayslake Nature Study & Photography Flickr site.

Award and Honorable Mention Digital Projected Images

If you have a DPI or print that receives a HM or Award in the monthly competition and wish to have it posted to the club's Flickr site, the image file must be named per the instructions below. The image size shall be as shown in the competition (not more than 1024x768)

If you want it displayed, rename it and then send it to steveornberg@yahoo.com by the following Monday after the competition night.

If you do not wish to have it displayed then do nothing.

The images will be uploaded to the Flickr site and posted in albums by competition date. In addition the EXIF date the image was taken may be changed to the competition date so they display with other images from the competition date.

Award and Honorable Mention Print Images

If it is a print, convert it to a DPI sized the same as DPI competition images (not more than 1024x768).

Name it per the instructions below and then send it to steveornberg@yahoo.com by the following Monday after the competition night.

Flickr Image Naming Instructions

The file name must contain the following information in the order shown:

*Title by Photographer's Name - Honor received (Award or HM) Competition Class (Class A or B)
Type (DPI or Print) - Month and Year of Competition*

Examples:

Got It! by John Janunas - Award Class A DPI - January 2016

Wave Action at Cave Point by Karl Knapp - HM Class B DPI - January 2016

Mossy Little River by Harry Hitzeman - Award Class B Prints -January 2016

Sunrise at Mt Sneffels by Steve Ornberg – Award Class A Prints - January 2016
